Musa Ibrahim travels on Emirates to conquer Mt Kilimanjaro

Dhaka : Mt. Everest hero Bangladesh's Musa Ibrahim has left for Dubai, en route to Dares Salaam to conquer Mt Kilimanjaro, the highest peak in the African continent as part of his Seven Summit Expedition.

Musa Ibrahim and fellow mountaineer Niaz Patwary, flew on Emirates, the airline of choice of Bangladeshis.
